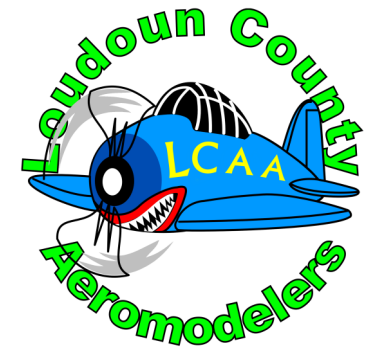

## SAFETY UPDATE

Throttle Cut is something highly recommended by, like **EVERYONE**. Know matter how sure we are that our plane's motor won't start up because we get distracted. It will happen to all of us. One way to help prevent that is to program a Throttle Cut switch for each and every model on our radios. Most radio's come with a Throttle cut feature that just needs to be enabled. Make sure to check your radio for this safety feature.
