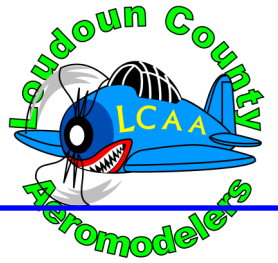


LCAA Airbag Lite

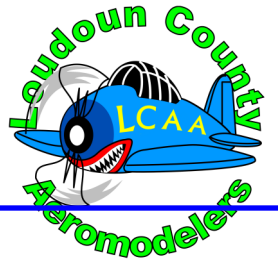
Just to note some of the things our dues get us:
